

ARMSTRONG & DISTRICT CURLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is “**ARMSTRONG & DISTRICT CURLING CLUB**”.
2. The objects of the Society are:
 - a. To organize, foster and promote the sport of curling in the community,
 - b. To promote good sportsmanship and fellowship among its members and all curling participants.
 - c. To promote community development by providing access to the sport of curling for all ages.
3. The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried out in the City of Armstrong and Surrounding District, Province of British Columbia.
4. To promote and assist in the raising of funds for the purpose of carrying out the objectives of the Society.
5. The Society guarantees that the facilities will be available by fee to any person or person who wish to use the facilities in accordance with the purpose, rules and regulations of the facilities.
6. To undertake other such activities, which from time to time, may be deemed appropriate.
7. The Society is not a member funded society.
