## SPARES POLICY

One of the benefits of belonging to [Curl BC](#) is that all our regular, registered curlers have injury coverage while they are in the club, curling or otherwise. This insurance is not available to casual curlers who are not registered as active curlers.

It is up to the skips of the teams to ensure that all of the spares that they may use are registered with the club and the skips are also responsible for the \$5.00 fee that we need to charge to pay for this coverage. A curler is considered to be "registered" if they have filled out a registration form and have written "spare only" on the line reserved for notes on the bottom part of the form.

Regular registered players (players who have paid to curl one or more days of the week) do not need to pay a spare fee unless they are sparing for a team that only has 3 players and perennially uses spares.

"Casual" curlers - curlers who are not members of a regular team during the current season or are not registered as a spare - must be registered prior to going on the ice and they, or their team, must pay a spare fee of \$5.00.

Also, if two players are sharing a position and one person has paid the club for the position and been reimbursed by their partner, please ensure that the person for which the club may have no record of, fills out a registration form so that they may be registered.
